Located just steps from the sand in PB, **The Duck Dive** is your classic beach bar and lounge. On National Bloody Mary Day, come in to tame your hangover with a **Bloody Buddy!** The combination of vodka, Cutwater Bloody Mary Mix, bacon and pepper jack cheese all served in a mason jar will help you feel better in no time.

For a family-friendly celebration, check out the New Year’s Day brunch at South Park’s **Del Sur Mexican Cantina**. Build a Bloody Mary that dreams are made of by adding bacon, olives, celery or bell peppers, and spice things up by sprinkling cayenne and red pepper flakes, among other spices.
