Two win trial delay in fentanyl death charge

AN DIEGO – Two people who are charged with involuntary manslaughter in the death of a Pacific Beach man, who overdosed on drugs they sold him, won a delay on Sept. 3 in their trial, and it was reset for Feb. 24, 2026.

Micah Rodgers Seau, 32, and Sheri Marie Cavanaugh, 60, waived their right to have a speedy trial in the death of Connor Gibson Gerhart, 31, when he overdosed on fentanyl in 2023.

They both appeared before San Diego Superior Court Judge Marian Gaston. They are both free on \$50,000 bond posted earlier, with the condition that they wear drug patches and a GPS device.

Seau is the nephew of the late Junior Seau, a former player with the San Diego Chargers who died at age 43 in 2012. Micah Seau also played Pop Warner football in school with the victim, who was a childhood friend of his. Gerhart died on June 1, 2023, in his Pacific Beach home. He graduated from La Jolla Country Day High School.

The trial of Seau and Cavanaugh was set to start on Sept. 22. However, the prosecutor stated that it was delayed, with the agreement of both defense counsel, due to witness unavailability and calendar conflicts. Seau and Cavanaugh had initially been charged with murder, but a judge reduced it to involuntary manslaughter.

Body of woman found after hit-and-run crash



AN DIEGO – The body of a 61-year-old woman was found Saturday afternoon, more than 12 hours after she was killed in a two-vehicle hit-and-run crash on Sea World Drive, officials said on Sept. 2.

The crash took place at around 12:20 a.m. near West Mission Bay Drive, according to the San Diego Police Department.

When officers arrived, both vehicles were at the scene, but one driver had fled on foot, police said.

The woman's body was discovered around 1 p.m. near the crash site, police said. Her name has not yet been released. Police said one vehicle rear-ended the other. No arrests have been made, and the cause of the crash remains under investigation.

AN DIEGO – The National Football League is back, and there are plenty of sports bars along the waterfront in Pacific Beach, Mission Beach, and La Jolla to choose from for fans to grab a bite or a brew and cheer on their favorite teams.

Here are just a few of the many local spots in Pacific Beach and Mission Beach that are haunts for some of the NFL's 32 teams:

In Pacific Beach, Duck Dive at 4650 Mission Blvd. offers an impressive lineup of game-time food and drink specials. Mavericks Beach Club at 860 Garnet Ave. offers 40 TVs in its five indoor/outdoor bars, so you won't miss a moment of action this season. Look to the Local PB, 809 Thomas Ave., for supporting specific teams like the Buffalo Bills. Tavern at the Beach at 1200 Garnet Ave. is known for showing all 32 NFL teams on 42 HD TVs.

In Mission Beach, Sandbar Sportsbar & Grill at 718 Ventura Place has TVs strategically placed downstairs, as well as on the SkyDeck for NFL viewing. Miss B's Coconut Club at 3704 Mission Blvd. is now a certified Packers bar and shows all Green Bay games on both indoor and outdoor TVs. They've even posted on their Instagram welcoming all "cheeseheads." Guava Beach Bar & Grill at 3714 Mission Blvd. is a known spot for Vikings fans
