The Lone Star Texas Brisket, is a signature dish at Brazen BBQ that includes brisket that has been rubbed down in a house made Brazen rub, smoked for hours and then sliced thin. It's no surprise that while competing, Brazen BBQ won the praised Rookie of the Year award, finished in California's top ten and placed in the nation's top 100.

Pizza and barbeque? Yes, please! <u>Woodstock's Pizza</u> is combining the best two items in the world of food. Their BBQ Bird pizza begins with a layer of bbq sauce topped with barbeque chicken, freshly sliced red onions and crispy bacon. This pizza puts all other pies to shame.
