Celebrate Christmas in the Gaslamp District at **Union Kitchen & Tap Gaslamp**, and delight in their **Prime Rib Special**plated with horseradish crème fraiche, potato fondants, jumbo asparagus and port wine demi-glaze, as well as their**Lobster "Cappuccino,"** a rich lobster bisque prepared with tarragon foam and shrimp chip, and finally their **Yule Log**, a decadent Bailey's sponge cake made with coffee buttercream, dark chocolate ganache, meringue and mulberry gel.
